First week back arrival and dismissal procedures

During our first week back (4 September) we will be asking Kestrels, Hawks and Eagles to go straight to class upon arrival in the morning. Unfortunately, there will be no daily mile due to welcoming 18 new Reception children via the main playground gate. From week 2, we will return to the option of doing the daily mile from 8.30am. Our new Reception class will meet their teachers in the gazebo on the playground until they are settled and able to join in the daily mile or head down to class. The gate will continue to be closed at 8.45am. Some of you may have already noticed that we have installed a new entry system in our main entrance and it should be fully functioning at the beginning of term. Should your child be late to school in the morning please make your way to the main entrance and sign in electronically. You will be asked your child's name and reason for being late. This will automatically feed to our register and save on administration. A member of staff will still come and meet you to take your child to class. The same will apply with collecting your child late in the afternoon and we will continue to ask that any late collections are met at the main entrance. Recurring late collections may incur an after school club charge.

Reception to Year 6 (ALL CLASSES) Whole School games every Friday. We are very excited to be working with Hayley and provide a 'Pound Class' for the Autumn term each Friday. Generation Pound is a youth-oriented

program that fuses movement and music! By combining exercise and interactive activities, children will learn new ways to explore movement, embrace creativity and ROCK OUT! Children will continue to come to school in their smart PE kits on PE days.

During Forest School children must bring a long sleeved top and trousers to get changed into, as well as a change of shoes, to be able to participate in these sessions. We have recently revised our risk assessments for Forest School and a change of suitable clothing is now compulsory.

Uniform

We are looking forward to seeing you all back in your smart uniforms in September. School uniforms promote a sense of pride and belonging. All clothing must be clearly marked with your child's name.
