SCIENCE GADGET SHOP!**

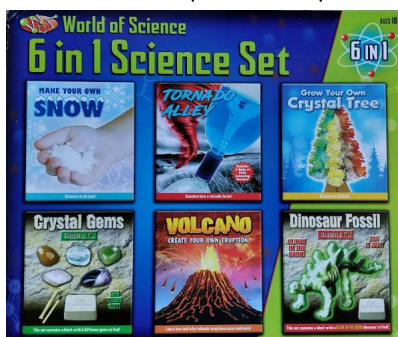
During the week beginning 11th March we will be celebrating British Science Week. Throughout the week we will be completing some special Science activities with the aim to enthuse and inspire the children and raise the profile of Science within our school. We will also be holding a very special SCIENCE GADGET SHOP everyday during the week in the gazebo at hometime.

Our 'Gadget Shop' is an exciting stall, jam packed with scientific and mathematical gismos, toys, games and gadgets, all aiming to promote a practical awareness of science and maths in the real world. These gadgets will all be selling at very cheap prices, so we hope every child will be able to buy something from the shop to ignite some scientific and mathematical excitement! (If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding please come and talk to us in confidence as we will be able to discount some prices for your child.)

The gadgets on the stall range from 50p-£3. On Monday 11th and Tuesday 12th March we've set a spending limit for each child of £4 in order to ensure every child gets a chance to choose their favourite gadget. From Wednesday 13th-Friday 15th March there will be no spending limit so the remaining stock will be up for grabs, still at bargain prices! Children who travel on the school bus will have the opportunity to visit the shop before leaving school. Please ensure bus children bring money in a small envelope with your child's name clearly labelled.
